- Maintain accurate guest records, ensuring confidentiality of personal information.
- Process payments and maintain cash handling procedures.
- Work with other campground departments to fulfill guest needs.
- Keep the office clean, organized, and presentable at all times.

- Assist with reservations and site assignments.
- Follow all safety and security protocols to help protect guests.
- Sign in inventory, stock coolers and shelves, and put supplies away.
- Maintain a clean front desk and store every day.
- Operate the Point-of-Sale system.
- Answer phones, return calls, Zings and respond to emails in a timely manner.
- Assist with campground activities, if/as needed.
- Cleaning of bathrooms, laundry room, cabins (after checkout) and pavilion area daily
- Cleaning outside signage, wobblers, windows etc
- Touching up with spray paint of pedestals, picnic tables, fire pits and water hydrants
- Touching up with latex paint of sign posts, picnic table canopies, and picnic tables
- If needed some light outdoor yardwork such as mowing sites might arise
