About the Role

The Cleaning Team is responsible for ensuring that all cabins, bathrooms, and shared facilities remain clean, stocked, and guest-ready at all times. This position is perfect for individuals who are detail-oriented, enjoy staying active, and take pride in their work.

Each team member must pass a background check prior to employment.

This role requires reliability, efficiency, and the ability to handle repetitive cleaning tasks with consistency and care. Team members may work closely together or independently based on daily needs.

Team Member Responsibilities

Cabin & Restroom Cleaning

- Clean and sanitize **bathrooms**, including toilets, sinks, showers, and floors.
- Clean, reset, and prepare cabins for incoming guests.
- Strip bedding, replace linens, make beds, vacuum/sweep/mop floors.
- Restock supplies: toiletries, paper products, kitchen items, and guest essentials.
- Ensure all cabins meet cleanliness and presentation standards.

Laundry & Stocking

- Maintain continuous laundry rotation throughout the workday.
- Wash, dry, fold, and stage linens for use between cleanings.
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of laundry areas.

Inventory & Supplies

- Track linen counts, cleaning product levels, toiletries, and cabin supplies.
- Notify management when inventory is low or needs replenishment.
- Restock carts, storage areas, and cabin closets as needed.

General Campground Support

- Assist other departments (grounds, maintenance, activities) when necessary.
- Follow safety procedures and proper chemical-handling guidelines.
- Report cabin issues, damages, or maintenance needs immediately.
- Work collaboratively to meet tight turnaround deadlines on high-occupancy days.
